How Manna Fights Hunger

Manna strives to end hunger across Montgomery County. With the continuing support of the community, Manna successfully provides food to tens of thousands of people each year through these four programs:

Family Food Distribution

Families and individuals can pick up a three-to-five day supply of perishable and shelf-stable food at one of thirteen Montgomery County locations. Clients may come to Manna

once a month, and all clients are referred to Manna by non-profit organizations, schools, doctors, employee assistance programs, faith-based organizations, and social workers.

Smart Sacks

Food insecure elementary school children at twenty schools receive a backpack filled with kid-friendly, nutritious food to eat on the weekends when there are no school meals to provide nourishment.

Bread Drops

Each week, Manna delivers bread to sixteen low-income community centers and apartment complexes.

Nonprofit Organizations

Manna provides free food to dozens of emergency shelters, group homes, soup kitchens, and food pantries so they can spend their resources on addressing the root causes of hunger rather than on feeding their clients.

Smart Sacks — Overcoming Childhood Hunger One Backpack at a Time



Through Smart Sacks, at-risk children receive bags of kid-friendly food on Fridays so they have enough to eat on the weekends when there are no school meals to nourish them. Instead of arriving at school on Monday listless and hungry, these children arrive at school

ready to learn. In FY08, five hundred elementary school students from twenty schools received a backpack each week containing ten to twelve items of nutritious food.

Partner organizations are an indispensable component of Smart Sacks. Each school is matched with a dedicated partner that fills the backpacks with easy-to-prepare food and brings them to their school. Many partner organizations even expanded their role. For example, Choice Hotels created enormous Thanksgiving baskets for the Smart Sacks families in their school. United Health Care collected coats, gloves, and books for their students. Whole Foods Markets provided shelf-stable milk for each child each week. Here's a round of applause for all our partner organizations.

A Year of Superlatives

What can one say about such a spectacular year? Manna collected more food than anytime during its twenty-five year history ... an awe-inspiring 2.4 million pounds of perishable and shelf stable food worth \$3.6 million. The generosity of our community was also evident in the record-breaking level of financial support Manna received during FY08. While many food banks across the nation struggled to keep up with demand, the exceptional compassion of Montgomery County residents enabled Manna to meet an unprecedented need for food.

Manna's corps of talented volunteers are, without a doubt, the most committed and hardest working. Volunteers from every corner of the county gave 32,000 hours of their time, the most ever given to Manna in one year. Manna would simply not be able to serve its clients without its volunteers.

Those are the positive superlatives. On the other side of the coin, due to the faltering economy and its ever-increasing prices for gas, food, and housing, many more of our neighbors needed Manna's help. Manna served nearly 25,000 families this past fiscal

year, a thirteen percent increase over FY07. A year ago, Manna provided food for an average of 88 households a day; now we serve an average of 99 families each day.



Manna anticipates that the need for one of humankind's most basic needs will expand in Montgomery County. Over the past five years, approximately fifty per-

cent more families have sought a three-to-five day supply of food from Manna. With no end to the economic downturn in sight, Manna anticipates many additional families will be requesting food. It will be a challenge to handle this continuing growth. By partnering with individuals, faith-based organizations, civic groups, foundations, corporations, and government agencies, Manna will have the resources to serve all who need help putting food on the table.
